Donation Acceptance Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in donating to the Habitat ReStore. We accept donations of new and used building materials & fixtures in 100% working condition from remodeling jobs, business closeouts, contractors and builders, and garage sales!

We appreciate your help in providing good quality building materials at greatly reduced prices and your support of Richmond Habitat for Humanity in building simple, decent, affordable houses in partnership with people in need.

APPLIANCES:

- Must be clean and in 100% working condition.
- Must have all knobs, trays, burners, shelves, etc.
- Must be 5 years old or newer.

CABINETS / COUNTERTOPS

- Only complete cabinets w/ all doors and drawers.
- Must be free of rot and in usable condition.

CARPET / LINOLEUM

- Only new carpet and linoleum will be accepted.

CARS

- Your car may be worth more as a donation than a trade-in because you get an itemized tax deduction based on the retail value of your vehicle. If your car still has value (it runs or only needs simple repairs), then you can get a significant tax saving by donating it. If you have a vehicle you would like to donate call the ReStore office at (804) 228-1305.

DOORS

- Must be in excellent condition, free of holes.
- Must not have rot, cracks, or separating.
- Doorknobs must be removed and bagged to sell separately.

DRYWALL

- Full or half sheets only
- No watermarks or broken edges

ELECTRICAL FIXTURES

- Accept electrical parts, lights, wire and hardware associated with electrical wiring.
- Only accept new or nearly new light fixtures in working order.

HARDWARE

- Accept hardware for doors, cabinets, etc.
- Must be in good condition and not rusty.

LUMBER / PLYWOOD / SIDING / TRIM

- Accept full and 1/2 sheets of new plywood.
- Accept full lengths of lumber or trim (8 ft minimum).
- Must be free of rot, nails, and screws.

PLUMBING FIXTURES

- Must be clean and in usable condition.
- Toilet tanks must include a tank top

ROOFING

- Shingles must be in complete packages.
- No metal roofing accepted.

TILE

- Accept vinyl and ceramic tile, new and clean.

WINDOWS

- Must be in new-like condition.
- No cracked or missing windowpanes
- Single paned steel and wood windows may be accepted with damaged panes.
- Wooden windows in need of paint usually accepted.

Please note that the following information is meant to serve as a general guide for donors. Acceptable items are subject to frequent change. Legal restrictions and limited storage capacity prevent the acceptance of some items. Please call if you are unsure about the acceptability of your donation.

If we are unable to accept your donation, ask for a list of other facilities that may be able to assist you.

We do not accept used carpet

We do not accept cabinet doors or drawers by themselves.
